The Caboose in Old Town has long been a focal point and landmark within the city for residents, visitors, and train enthusiasts. In recent years, a new ramp and gazebo were added to provide additional seating and safety at this site. Completion of this proposed effort will allow for the beauty to last for years and provide additional safety.

- Proposal -

- Amend current fiscal year budget to use existing WFA funds to stain the existing ramp and gazebo along with replacement of the existing aluminum spindles with sturdy and decorative spindles to match other area businesses and add additional safety

- Price Breakdown -

➤ Staining of Ramp and Gazebo	\$3,575.00
➤ New Spindles (375 total)	1,947.00
TOTAL	\$5,522.00

- Benefits -

- Staining will be two coats of semi-transparent stain
- Staining the wooden ramp and gazebo will allow for weather protection
- Replacing the spindles would prevent them from slipping out of place as the existing ones are currently doing
- The modifications will add beauty and uniformity to the gazebo enhancing the Caboose for years to come
- The replacing of spindles can be performed by the Public Works Department saving on labor costs

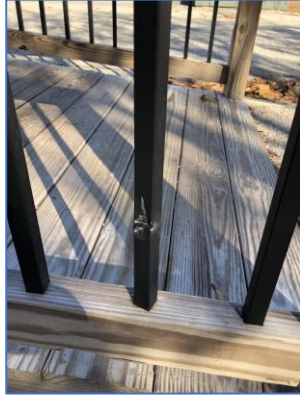

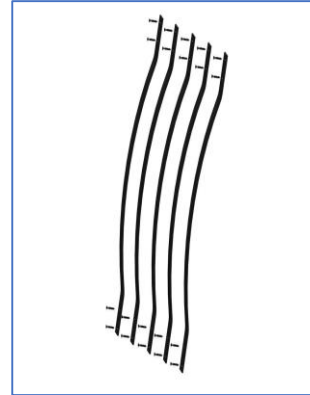
